MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Southbound I-5 Closures for Column Construction: Closure of southbound I-5, from the I-805 merge to Gilman Drive, is scheduled for Tuesday, June 5, at 11:00 p.m. to Wednesday, June 6, at 5:00 a.m. Crews will be drilling and pouring concrete to build the column structures for the viaduct to carry the Trolley across the freeway. Traffic controls will be placed and travelers should follow detours or seek alternate routes. Construction schedule subject to change.

Night work on I-5: In January, crews began work on the viaduct – a bridge structure that will carry the Trolley down I-5. This work is focused within the median of I-5 and requires intermittent lane closures. To prepare for this construction, crews have demolished the median and restriped traffic lanes on both northbound and southbound I-5 between the Nobel Drive and La Jolla Colony Drive exits. Drilling work in the median and along the sides of I-5, from La Jolla Colony Drive to Voigt Drive, starts in late March 2018. Drilling hours are Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Some night work may be required. This median work will be ongoing through late summer 2018.

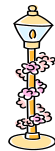
